RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

(to be executed by individuals that are at least 18 years old)

(Read this document carefully before signing; it is a legal document that affects your legal rights.)

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release") is executed on [DATE] _____ by [NAME] _____ (the "Volunteer") in favor of Cobb Disaster Recovery, Inc., a Georgia nonprofit corporation, and its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents (collectively, "CDR").

The Volunteer desires to work as a volunteer for CDR and engage in activities related to CDR's goal of assisting individuals and families affected by disaster (the "Activities"). In consideration of CDR's allowing the Volunteer to engage in the Activities, the Volunteer, being at least 18 years of age, hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress, agrees as follows:

Release and Waiver. The Volunteer understands that the Activities may include intense physical labor, strenuous activity, traveling to work sites or other tasks which entail a risk of physical injury. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless CDR and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's participation in the Activities. Volunteer understands that this Release discharges CDR from any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against CDR with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, property damage or other harm that may result from Volunteer's participation in the Activities, whether caused by the negligence of CDR or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer also understands that CDR does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

Medical Treatment. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge CDR from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with CDR.

Insurance. Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by CDR in writing, CDR does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer. Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.
